To be admitted to UMD-COB with the 2+2 Program, students must meet the following requirements.

- 1. Complete all curriculum requirements before transferring to UMD-COB.
- Receive a minimum grade of sixty-five (65) in all curriculum requirements taken at PSUT.
- 3. Have a minimum grade point average of 2.70, based on a 4.0 scale, as calculated by UMD-Office of Undergraduate Admissions.
- 4. Meet UMD's English language proficiency requirements.
