My teaching style is rooted in my conviction that education should be a catalyst for change, equipping students with both the technical expertise and the attitude and moral compass necessary to lead with purpose in a world that is increasingly interconnected and evolving daily. By creating and implementing courses that directly address new industry demands and the changing digital economy, I have spearheaded revolutionary developments in business technology education over the last five years. Above all, I oversaw the improvement of four courses:

- Principles of Management
- Human Resource Management
- Purchasing and Inventory Management

With a 15% increase in enrollment over five years, these courses were designed to close the gap between traditional business education and the technologically advanced fields of contemporary organizations, establishing KTSBT as a pioneer in technology-integrated business education. To ensure curriculum relevance and graduate employability, each course was developed through industry-academia collaboration, incorporating feedback from alumni, business partners, and international thought leaders. For instance, the Purchasing and Inventory Management course enables students to engage in real-world projects that address practical business challenges by incorporating real-world statistics and problem-solving scenarios from partner firms.
